Need books or ebooks?

- 1) Search the Brooklyn College Library **Catalog**.
- 2) Search the **CUNY-wide Catalog** (in the catalog, click **Select All CUNY Libraries**). Use the catalog's book request feature to have books from other CUNY libraries sent to this library.
- 3) If nobody in CUNY has the book you want, request it through **Interlibrary Loan**.

Need articles?

Try searching one or more of these databases (all are accessible through the **Databases** page):

- **American Institute of Physics:** Scitation is AIP's Online Journal Publishing Service, home for more than 110 technical publications from 18 STM publishers and a fixture in the online publishing world since 1996. Scitation is the online home of more than 100 journals from AIP, APS, ASCE, ASME, SPIE, and a host of other prestigious science and engineering societies.
- **Applied Science and Technology Index:** This database covers many fields within science and technology, including chemistry.

- **Institute of Physics Journals (United Kingdom):** Full electronic access on the World Wide Web to journals in physics, engineering, and technology from the Institute of Physics and other publishers.
- **Scopus:** A database covering articles from over 15,000 peer-reviewed titles from more than 4,000 international publishers including 531 open access journals with links to full text. Records cover 1966 to the present from scientific, technical and social science.
